



BISMA OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP 2016

1. You will see from the Notice of Race (paragraph 3) that registration for the championship is by entry for both parts, and by notifying Julie that you have done so at Julie@6mr.org.uk, and julie@jonesgirls.co.uk. **Please enter ASAP.**
2. The Organising Authority for Part 1 is the Royal Solent Yacht Club, and entry is by entering for its Queen's Jubilee Regatta. The appropriate entry form is attached. The entry fee payable to the Royal Solent is £100.
3. The Organising Authority for Part 2 is the Royal Southern Yacht Club, and entry is by entering for its Summer Series June Regatta. Entry can be done on line to <https://www.royal-southern.co.uk/Afloat/On-line-Entry/>. The relevant entry fees are members - £58, non-members £75.
4. Berthing at Yarmouth - Berths have been reserved for us in Yarmouth Harbour; but payment should be made to the Harbour Master. They are well aware that 6's are engineless; and help will be on hand for berthing and subsequently for leaving and re-entering the harbour.
5. There will be a briefing for Part 1 at 6pm on Friday 3rd at the Royal Solent Yacht Club.
6. BISMA reception - on the eve of the championship - Friday 3rd June from 6:30pm pm. The reception is to be held at The Towers (next door to the Royal Solent) at the kind invitation of John Caulcutt. The tickets will be £17.50 per head. Could those who have not yet done so, please notify Julie of your intention to attend and numbers again **ASAP**, so that the arrangements can be finalized with only 3 weeks remaining.
